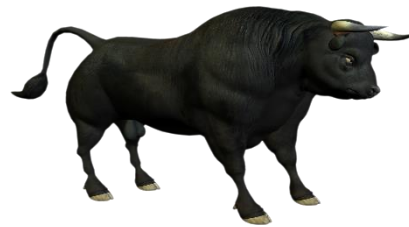
Keep thinking about joining us in the St. Patrick's Day Parade.....I'd
